Locally, she also enjoyed being on stage performing in the Equity Production of Beauty and the Beast as well as a high-kick dancer in Universal Studios' Christmas Parade. Her skills as a dancer have taken her all around the world and her work has won her many awards and scholarships at numerous competitions and conventions. Bo has performed with Dollywood, Royal Caribbean, Norwegian and Disney cruise lines and has danced alongside Dolly Parton and his favorite, Minnie Mouse! He has worked for Walt Disney World and has been featured in Beauty and the Beast:Live On Stage, The Hoop Dee Doo Revue, Dream Along with Mickey, ABC's Annual Christmas Day Parade, and the live christening of the DCL Disney Dream cruise liner with Jennifer Hudson. Bo made his Off Broadway debut in the musical Trip Of Love starring Nia Souix and Darlene Love ultimately becoming the production's dance captain. Bo has taught and adjudicated with studios across the southeast and worked with masters such as Gwen Verdon, Ann Reinking and Ben Vereen. Bo's directorial and choreographic work has been nominated for Broadway World and MTA awards and includes show creation for Carowinds Theme Park and Celebrity Cruise Line.

Brittany Noltimier is a professional dancer, mentor, and nationally recognized adjudicator who brings over 14 years of professional stage experience and a lifelong passion for the performing arts to every event she judges. She is the Artistic Director and owner of Central Florida Performing Arts (CFPA) in Orlando, FL, a children's theater company founded in 1998 to help kids build confidence, learn new skills, and find a place to belong through theater and dance.

Brittany grew up dancing at her mother's studio, Miki's School of Dance in North Dakota, and holds a Bachelor of Performing Arts in Dance Performance from Oklahoma City University. There she received professional training in ballet, tap, jazz, musical theater, voice, acting, and dance pedagogy.

Her performance credits include roles in West Side Story (Estella), Footloose (Rusty), Legally Blonde, Fiddler on the Roof, Nunsense, and professional magic shows. Brittany has graced stages at Walt Disney World (Equity dancer in "A Totally Tomorrowland Christmas"), Universal Studios (Dance Captain for "Grinchmas Who-liday Spectacular"), Legoland Florida (vocalist in the original "Lego Friends" show), and SeaWorld/Aquatica as a singer, dancer, and actor.

As a seasoned judge and master class teacher, Brittany serves with Full Out, Talent on Parade, Starquest, Inspire, the National Performing Arts Festival at Universal Orlando, the FL and GA Thespian Conferences, and more. Each year, she sees over 10,000 routines and brings high standards, expertise, and encouragement to every dancer she critiques. She is also the creator of The Fame Method, a signature system designed to help performers break through confidence barriers and develop elite-level stage presence. Brittany launched a Mastermind program for high-achieving competitive dancers ages 9–17, focused on accelerating progress and helping families maximize their dancer's prime years.

In January 2020, Brittany and her mother brought American musical theater to students at a school in Uganda, Africa
—led by hometown friends—as a cultural exchange initiative. This unique experience offered students theatrical
opportunity and creative expression, enriching lives through the power of performance.

Through her podcast "Dance Colleges and Careers" and weekly YouTube videos (abrittanynoltimier), Brittany shares real-world advice on dance education, college auditions, and performance careers. Her mentorship spans from elementary to collegiate levels, guiding students toward personal growth and professional opportunities.



What will you miss most about your studio?


Definitely my teammates and coaches. They've truly become my second family.
